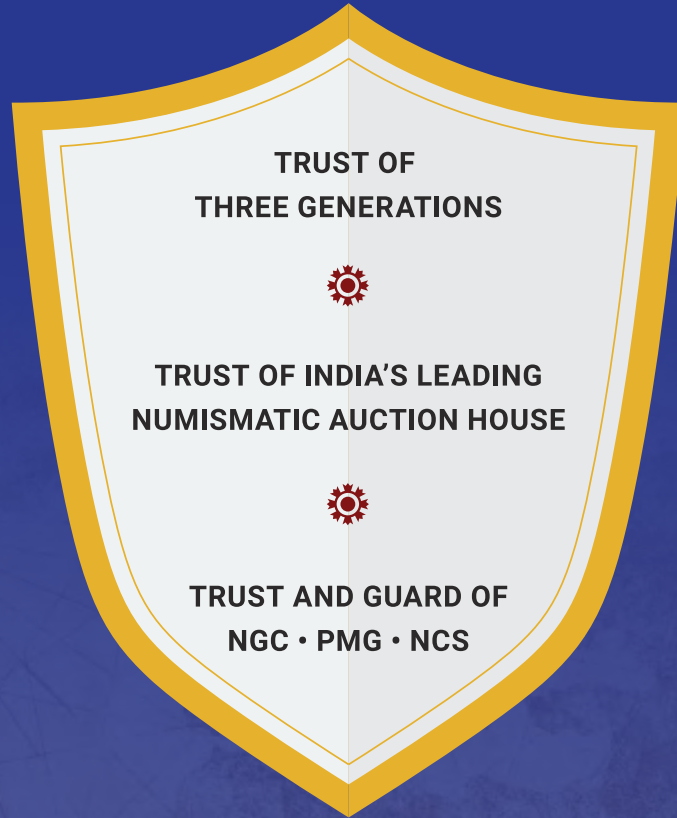

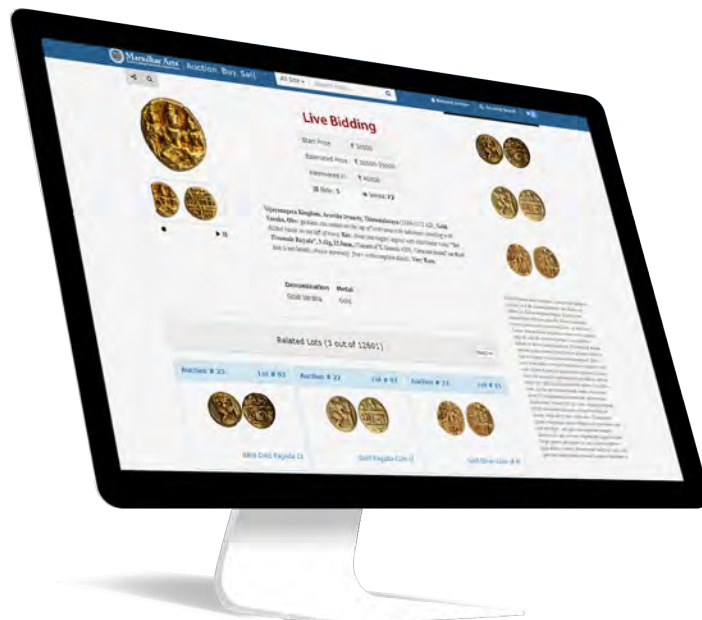

Punch Marked Coin

Shakya Janapada (600-500 BC)

1. **Archaic Series, Silver 5 Shana**, Narhan Hoard type I, Scyphate coinage, **Obv:** circular mark bold punch with five pellets around a circle in the centre and ancillary symbols around, **Rev:** uniface and scyphate, **6.61g, 26.87x19.8mm**, (Rajgors Series 33/Hardekar, 2019 # NH 35), about very fine, **Very Rare.**

Estimated Price: 6000-7000

2. **Archaic Series, Silver 5 Shana**, Narhan Hoard type I, Scyphate coinage, **Obv:** central symbol with four small dots around square pellet, all within quatrefoil and ancillary symbols around, **Rev:** uniface and scyphate, **6.64g, 28.08x17.7mm**, (unlisted type in Rajgors/Hardekar, 2019 # NH 32), about very fine, **Very Rare.**

Fish on the coins of this series has not been reported earlier, this type is discovered recently from Uttar Pradesh and remains unreported and unpublished so far.

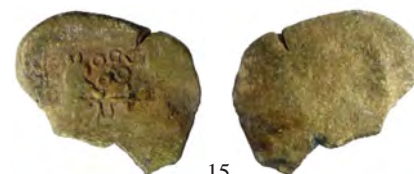

20. **Amoghbuti (200 BC), Silver Drachma, Obv:** A Deer standing to the right with square-shaped vase above its back, early Srivatsa symbol between its horns, **three arched hill with parasol below the deer**, goddess Lakshmi standing facing in front of the Deer, holding lotus flower in upraised right hand, Brahmi legend around **“Rajnah Kunindasya Amoghbutisya Maharajasya”**, (Great king Amoghbuti, of The Kunindas), **Rev:** centrally placed six arched hill with wavy river line below, Nandipada on top, Swastika above, an indradhvaja and a tree in railing, Kharoshthi legend around **“Rana Kunindasa Amoghbutisa Maharajasa”**, (Great king Amogh, of the Kunindas), **2.15g, 17.52mm**, (variant of JONS by Sanjeev Kumar 218 # Type II, Class-5/Handa # Pl. XIII), *about extremely fine*, **Rare**. **Estimated Price:** 3500-4000

21. **Sangam Cholas (200 BC), Copper Square Unit, Obv:** Tiger standing facing left, tail and right front leg raised, **Rev:** Elephant standing left with Srivatsa symbol above, Horse standing left behind the Elephant, **1.07g, 13.29x11.12mm**, (W. An interesting coin which could have been struck with the influence from those of Satavahanas Lion type. It was struck by the Chutukulananda from the North Karnataka region, **“Rajno Chutkulnanda”** is the arrangement of legends what we see on the coins from this dynasty.

First reported coin for the type.

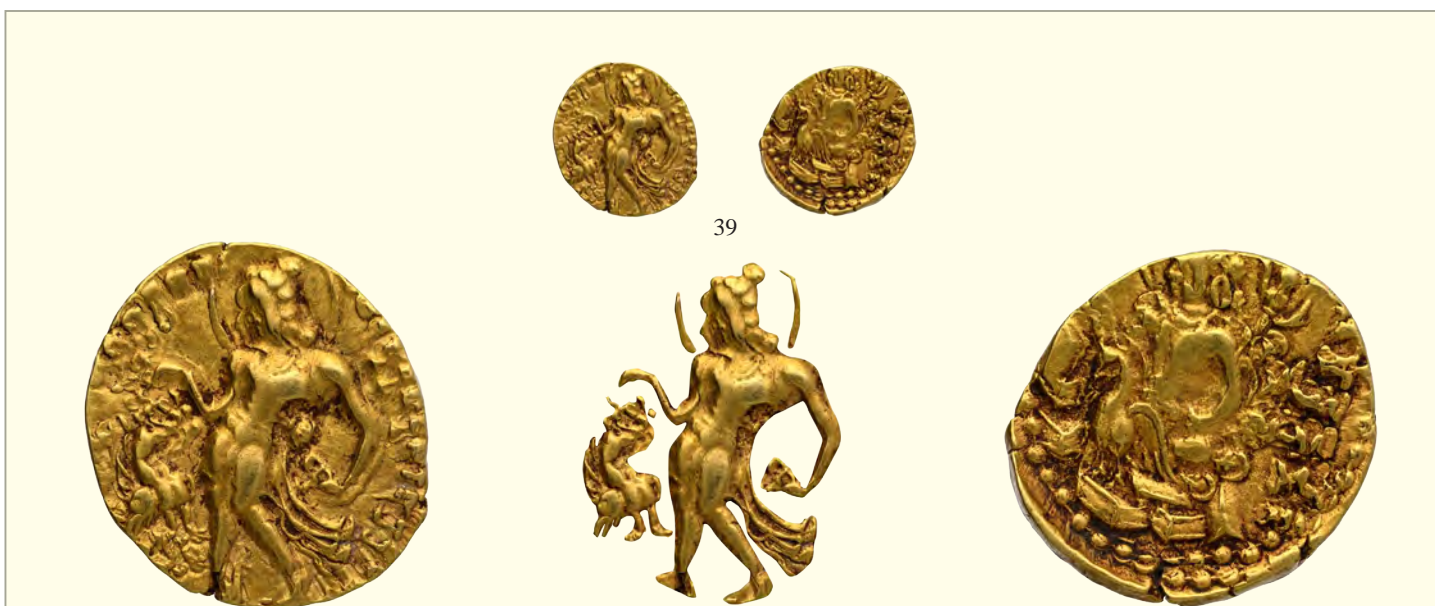

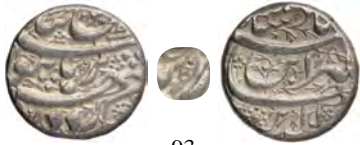

This coin is widely believed to have been struck during Charles II's reign at Bombay in 1763. The Persian legends on both sides have not been read successfully though it has great resemblance with that of the Rupees of James II, William and Queen Mary. The earliest East India Company coinage bearing Persian inscriptions began to circulate during the time of Charles II. In 1763, Martin Folkes reported that "the English Merchants trading in the East Indies struck silver money in India for the use of their factory at Bombaim. Of these he had seen the Anglina, Pax Deo and a third sort of rupee which had again only the Company's arms on the one side and Arabic or Indian characters on the other." Pridmore says that the Surat Council's comment upon the inscription 'Charles the second, King of England' perhaps indicates that while the obverse was the normal Anglina type, the reverse was inscribed in Persian with that above inscription. The above coin has Persian inscriptions on both sides. In 1681, a pirate named Henry Bridgeman (also known as Every) attacked and captured a ship called the Ganj-e-Sawai carrying a cargo of 6 Lakh Rupees and many people returning from the Haj. His capture of the ship and abuse of the people aboard outraged the Indian Princes on the Western Coast. Mughal chronicler Khafi Khan recorded: "This loss was reported to Aurangzeb, and the newswriters of the port of Surat sent some rupees which the English had coined at Bombay, with a Superscription containing the name of their impure King. Aurangzeb then ordered that the English factors who were residing at Surat for commerce should be seized. Orders were also given to Itimad Khan, superintendent of the Port of Surat, and Sisi Yakut Khan, to make preparations for besieging the fort of Bombay.
